When should I submit my Experimental Animation Application Form?

The application can be submitted after having passed Sophomore Portfolio Review.

If you fail any or all portions of the Sophomore Portfolio, but then pass them after successfully completing the intensive(s) course(s) over the summer, then you can complete the form after completion of the course(s).

Steps to take for the Experimental Animation Application Form submission:

- 1. Print out and complete the Application Form (see below)
- 2. Meet with faculty member Scott Hall regarding your entry into the program. If he agrees, he will need to sign this form.
- 3. Schedule an appointment with an academic advisor in SVAD Advising, Nicholson School of Communication Building, Room 121. You may schedule the appointment by calling: 407-823-1355
- 4. Bring your completed Application Form (including faculty signature) with you to the advising meeting along with a copy of a degree audit showing registration in ART 3950 (Sophomore Portfolio).
- 5. When you meet with an academic advisor to review your application form, at that time, your academic eligibility will be determined.
- 6. If your application is accepted, you will be asked to complete a Restricted Access Change of Major Form. This will be the last step to have your major officially changed to BFA Art Emerging Media Experimental Animation Specialization.
